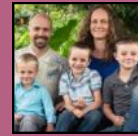

This represents many years of work by some friends of ours, as well as two generations of local Bible translators.

There were a number of logistics hurdles, and up until a few weeks prior to the date that had been set we weren't sure it would happen. But God's people came together and it went very well as people celebrated the coming of God's Word in their language. 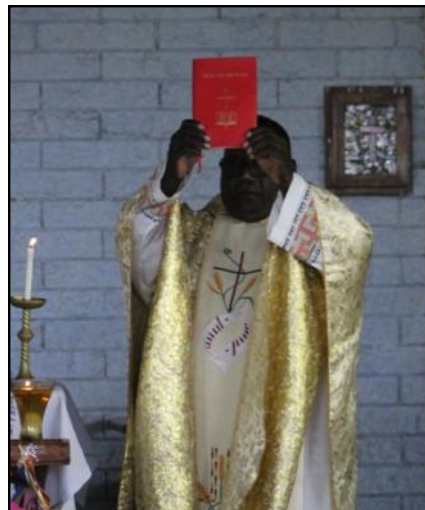
### Prayer Corner
