In December we needed around an additional \$1,500 per month. As of this writing, we only need **\$408 per month** to be released to go back. We are so close!

We also were facing an incredible challenge as to how to physically get back to Papua New Guinea, with the only reliable once-a-month flight method being cancelled after January. Just yesterday we got news that another flight has been added in mid-February. We are really hoping to make that flight, but we cannot book flights until we are pretty certain about the financial side of things. Please pray that it all comes together.
